We've pulled together some quick and easy guidance on how you can enjoy Nozstock in the most sustainable fashion below!

1. Make sure to retrieve your fiver by bringing back a bag full of rubbish or recycling to the [ECO BOND](#) exchange from Sunday afternoon (3PM - 8PM) 'til Monday lunchtime (7:30AM - 1PM)!
2. We are asking everyone to 'GET READY TO REFILL' and use the delicious, free water available from all our taps and bars to refill their water bottles. We will not be selling plastic bottles onsite.
3. Limit (or completely eliminate) single use plastic and waste! Ditch the old fashioned plastic glitter in favour of shiny planet-happy biodegradable glitter, invest in reusable sanitary products and cut out plastic cutlery from your rucksack. Make sure that you only bring along the amount of food you intend to consume to reduce waste.
4. The tent judges are about to judge your campsites on cleanliness, awarding prizes to the best tents and the tidiest campsites, including merchandise, trophies and free festival tickets! Think green, clean and sustainable. The CLEAN CAMPSITE COMPETITION award ceremony will be on Sunday at the Bandstand, so get creative, and we'll see you there!
5. [LOVE YOUR TENT](#) and take it home! Show us that you've wised up to the myth that all tents can be donated and take responsibility in ensuring you leave your patch of grass as found.

6. We run a FREE shuttle bus from Bromyard to the festival site as well as booked coaches. These run from Bristol Temple Meads, London Kings Cross St Pancras and Hereford Train Station, with return journeys available on Monday, making travelling sustainably to the festival a doddle! Find the running times @ the INFO HUT & Book via the ticket page. We encourage people to leave the gas guzzlers at home and take advantage of car sharing.
7. Get involved in a workshop or hang around for our talks on sustainability! We boast funky junk workshops to willow weaving, why not commit to attending one over the weekend?
